The two dispute solution mechanisms available for international commercial

transactions – domestic courts and arbitration – are profoundly different as to their

legal nature, their procedural functioning, the way in which they apply the

substantive rules and in many other important respects.

In his keynote, Professor Radicati di Brozolo will answer how these differences

impact on the parties' choice and why arbitration is the preferred, and often the

only, option. In addition, he will address whether the "international commercial

courts" that some states have created or are in the process of launching, are a

useful alternative to the real or perceived shortcomings of the two traditional

mechanisms.

Professor Luca G. Radicati di Brozolo holds the chair of Private International Law

at the Catholic University of Milan. His abundant scholarly writings cover a broad

range of subjects. In 2018 he gave the General Course on Private International

Law at the Hague Academy of International Law on "The legal framework of

international commercial transactions".

He is also a well-known practitioner who now focuses primarily on international

commercial and investor-state arbitration as advocate, arbitrator and expert. He

is the founder of the arbitration and litigation boutique ArbLit – Radicati di Brozolo

Sabatini Benedettelli Torsello and a door tenant at Fountain Court Chambers in

London.
